2017 Mile High Tournament Rules

1. Regular high school rules will be used, unless otherwise noted.
2. Players must compete in their own grade classification, with the exception that lower grade participants may play up. Players can only play on one team within same division.
3. No player may be added to roster after team has played one game.
4. All teams must have uniform shirts with visible numbers.
5. Game time is forfeit time. You may start a game with 4 players.
6. Game length is 2-18 minutes halves with running clock. Clock will be stopped during all dead balls the last 2 minutes of game only if the score is within 10 points.
7. Alternate possessions on jump balls after the initial jump.
8. Players are allowed five fouls.
9. Free throw will be shot, bonus on the seventh team foul, two shots after tenth team foul each half.
10. Three point shots will be used on courts that are properly marked.
11. Substitutions will be made on dead balls only.
12. Teams are allowed three time-outs per game. Time-outs do not carry to overtime.
13. Halftime is three minutes (if games are on schedule).
14. Overtime will be two minutes with the clock stopping (if games are on schedule), one time-out per team in overtime.
15. Each team must supply its own warm up balls.
16. Each team must supply one person for clock and scorekeeping (**PLEASE remember these people are volunteers, not professionals**).
17. Each team will be responsible for bringing its own first aid supplies.
18. No locker room available.
19. No pressing after a ten point lead.
20. All defenses are allowed with the exception of grades 4th & 5th – no zone.
21. Technical fouls will be 2 points and possession.
22. Coaches are responsible for players and spectators of their own team.
23. Referees may remove a player, coach or spectator from any game, or the entire tournament, for unsportsmanlike conduct.
24. **Confirmation:** It is coach's responsibility to ensure that the Handley Recreation Center has received team registration. A confirmation e-mail will be sent to coach upon receiving. If coaches do not receive this e-mail, please call 584-1113.
